We are in pretty constant contact with the boys in the program through texts, FaceTime and Zoom. We meet by school, by grade, by weekly group. Our young men miss meaningful connection with their schools and their friends. 10th graders are coping, 12th graders are sad about the losses of senior year. In addition to the disruption in their schedules many are dealing with almost daily neighborhood violence. Some of their families have been affected by Covid-19.

College news

We have college acceptances ranging from Olin School of Engineering, U Mass Amherst Isenberg School of Business, BU, Northeastern, Bentley and Wentworth. Other students are going to BFIT for auto technology, and one to the military with the goal to become a police officer (we connected him to BPD Officer Mike who attends Hyde Park meetings).
